DIRECTIONS

- Subway Karasuma Line, Shijo Station: 3-min walk
- From JR Kyoto Station: Take Subway Karasuma Line to Shijo Station, or take a taxi (approx. 5min.)
- From Kansai International Airport: 75-min by JR Haruka Express train to JR Kyoto Station
- From Osaka International Airport: 55-min ride by airport limousine bus

Largest meeting room is the "Rose" with maximum meeting space of 357 square meters and maximum seating capacity of 330.

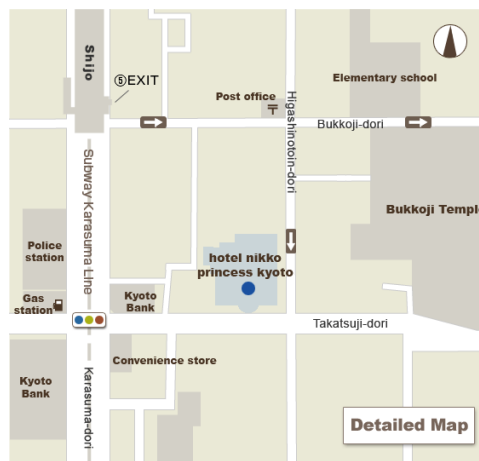
RESTAURANTS AND BAR
